The Boys' Brigade 70th London Company Captains Report-May 2000

The Past twelve months has been a year of transition for the company, with changes to days and programme's in two of the three sections. It is perhaps too early to see if the effects of these changes will be beneficial in the long run, but the changes have been to some extent forced due to the age structure of the membership and the limited staffing resources available to the company. At the current time membership stand at 46. With 13 Juniors, 10 Company & 23 Seniors. The former two groups meeting on Wednesdays with the latter on Fridays.

The Company & Junior Sections have throughout the year carried out a traditional programme of badge work and other activities with the results reflected in the list of badges & credits being awarded at the display tonight. The wide range of activities reflects the whole spectrum of brigade work including crime prevention, road safety, gym, physical activity, drill & Christian Education. The Senior Section programme has involved a mix of activities with one week in two operating off site. The funding for this has been made possible by two grants from the Sir Walter St Johns's Charitable trust & the Yapp Foundation. We further to hope to expand this work with new IT equipment from a grant from the Bridge House Trust Fund. Attendance within this 15-18 year age group has been variable as the Company has to compete with other activities and school & College work. The photo sheet attached give a view of some of the Company activities over the past twelve months.

The company has not neglected the spiritual side of things with regular devotions in the week and Bible Class on Sunday mornings, the latter is shared with the GB. Another joint activity with more girls than boys this time is the steel band. This is in great demand and has made just under 20 appearances in the past 12 months and is fully booked over the summer. The band is taught by Paul Dowie, who has introduced a number of new tunes and arrangements over the past year.

In the competition front the company has had a mixed year winning the London district five a side football, six & eleven a side cricket & basketball. In addition the Company provided the whole of the battalion teams that retained the Athletics & Football trophies. In other events we have been runners up in the district cross country, junior section football & gym. In the five National Competitions the company had a degree of success in the badminton reaching the English final where we lost on a playoff, and in the Five a side finals we were beaten in the group stages 1-0 by the eventual winners the 3rd Airdrie. At the battalion level the Junior Section retained both the six a side football & Swimming.

Camp last year was at Ringmer in Sussex, 23 boys attended and a wide range of activities including go karting, swimming and other outdoor activities took place. For this year we will be returning to Swanage.

The Company staff has been supplemented this year with Eze Nwatuobi & Jason Hall both completing officers basic training. Myself, Jim Ballard & Barry Green have all completed the compulsory Brigade renewal training and are thus able to continue to serve. The attendance of the staff at renewal training enables us to review our programmes and keep updated with any changes to statutory provisions.

The Company is ably supported by a team of volunteer staff from the officers (Jim Ballard, Barry Green & Giles Palmer) through to Camp staff, drivers, band helpers

and those who help out at ad hoc events, I am grateful to all of those who give of their time to enable the boys to develop and to truly be the best that they can be.

The Company also tries to help others with the GB we again provided stewards for an event at the Town Hall , while the Junior & Company section raised over £350 for the Royal National Lifeboat Institute with a sponsored tour of the Monopoly board.

The Company along with everyone else is entering into a future that is fast changing but we hope that while providing a modern programme we will indeed remain "Sure & Steadfast" to the Object of the Boys' Brigade.

The Juniors are back again with the sower sowing his seeds in a version of "the Parable of the Sower"

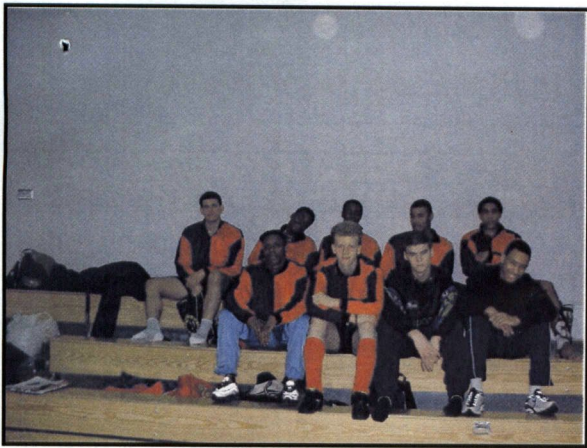
Finally, we are not able to show you everything we do in the year so, the boys now demonstrate most of the rest of the programme.

We now reach the bit the boys are interested in the Presentation of awards by our Chaplain the Rev. Alastair Clark followed by some words from him.

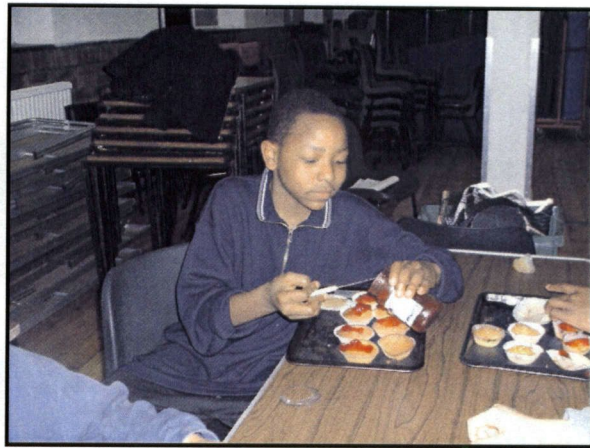

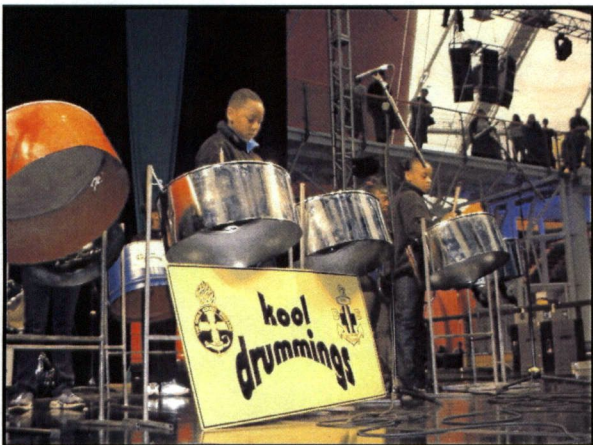
